One wrote from Aleppo in February describing the terrible new poverty, which he said was even worse than the pandemic "The Syrian economy is suffering major collapse, high inflation, uncontrollable high prices for food, transportation, medicine, fuel, gas and clothing." The churches are struggling to provide even a little help to their congregations "in this bleeding and financially exhausted country." Prayer was requested that the crops in Syria could be gathered in safely this year, and not set on fire by Turkish armed forces just before harvest-time.
