Prayer Focus



Christian-majority Ethiopia experienced prolonged drought from 2020 to 2023. This caused widespread food insecurity and was devastating for farmers. This period of drought was followed by floods from September 2023 to March 2024. The floods killed livestock and caused crop losses, which heightened the existing food insecurity. This hunger was compounded by conflict which has hindered Ethiopia's economy - many people are now unable to afford even the bare essentials. As of September 2024, 10.8 million Ethiopians are at critical levels of food insecurity. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Ethiopia, that they will obtain enough food to sustain them, and that the Lord will give them strength through this time of great struggle.
